Job Summary:

The bus person assists servers and provides guests service by quickly and thoroughly cleaning and setting food serving and dining areas.

Essential Job Functions:

- Clears and cleans tables, chairs, counters and surrounding areas in a discrete manner.
- Resets tables and ensures each table has appropriate accompaniments.
- Interacts pleasantly with all guests, while responding quickly to special requests.
- Assists servers by expediting activities and providing requested beverage items.
- Checks and refills coffee, pop, syrup, cups, and condiments.
- Must maintain excellent attendance and be available to work events and varied schedules per business need.
- Maintains a professional and tidy appearance at all times.
- Performs other special projects and duties as assigned.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Ability to work in a team-oriented, fast-paced, event-driven environment.
- Ability to communicate with team members, management staff and guests in a clear, business-like and respectful manner which focuses on generating a positive enthusiastic and cooperative work environment.
- Ability to clearly communicate read and write in English.

Education, Qualifications and Experience:

- Experience working in a fast-paced, quick service environment is preferred but not required
- Must acquire and maintain a valid Washington State Food Handlers Card, Alcohol Awareness Certification, Suspicious Activity, Blood Borne Pathogen (BBP) and other required compliance trainings.
- All employees must obtain a valid gaming license from the State Gaming Agency and Tribal Gaming Office prior to beginning work and are required to have license renewed annually.

Uniforms:

Uniforms will be specific to each outlet. All hair must be completely contained within the approved health standards. All hairstyles, body art and piercings must adhere to company policy to meet the needs of the health code and professional standards.
