## **Active Shooter**

Quickly determine the most logical means to protect yourself.

Guests, vendors, and visitors are likely to follow the lead of team members during this type of situation.

RUN	HIDE	FIGHT
<ul> <li>Have an escape route and a plan in mind</li> <li>Leave your belongings behind</li> <li>Keep your hands visible</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Hide in an area out of the active shooter's view</li> <li>Block entry to your hiding place and lock the doors</li> <li>Arm yourself with whatever is available</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>As a last resort and only when your life is in imminent danger</li> <li>Attempt to incapacitate the active shooter</li> <li>Act with physical aggression and throw items at the shooter</li> </ul>

## CALL 911 and overhead page ACTIVE SHOOTER if safe to do so.

## How to Respond When Law Enforcement Arrives

- Remain calm and follow officer instructions
- Immediately put your arms up and palms facing out
- Keep your hands visible at all time
- Avoid making quick movements towards officers
- Do not attempt to grab onto officers or run behind them
- Avoid screaming or yelling
- Do not attempt to talk to officers
- Be guiet and compliant
- Speak only if asked questions
- Follow directions that officer gives you

## Information to Provide to Law Enforcement or 911 Operators

Provide the following information if it is known

- Location of the active shooter
- Direction of travel
- Physical description
- Total number and type of weapon(s)
- Any casualties or hostages
